- **Institute of Medicine (IOM)**

 - Is a component of the National Academy of Sciences (NAS)

 - Avoid bias and conflict of interest
 - Reports go extensive review and evaluation
 - Anonymous group of experts
 - Board review
 - Funders formulate the questions but have not input into the outcome of the report
- **Survey of disciplines**
 - Identify priorities in important science areas
- **Roundtables and Forums**
 - Neutral forum for controversial issues
